
As to the piece itself, this spout cup was bought from Willoughby Farr by Mr. Vogel many years ago at the same time that he bought a flat top tankard from the Van der Voordt family in New York. I have the piece from Mr. Vogel's widow.

The spout cup was on exhibition in the Brooklyn Museum of Art with all of the other Myer Meyers silver in 1954. I will mail you the complete check list of the 1954 exhibition which you may have for your records. It was not included in the Rosenbaum book because the Rosenbaum book was published before the cup was exhibited at the museum. As a matter of fact, most of the good Myer Meyers pieces are not in the Rosenbaum book.

This is the earliest piece of Myer Meyers silver that I have ever seen. There is a small crack in the side of the bowl which was repaired on the inside many years ago. Otherwise, there are no repairs or restorations.

I unconditionally guarantee this spout cup to be made by Myer Meyers during his early period.
