Dear Mr. Moore:

I bid up to \$20,000 on the Samuel Vernon tankard, but as I suspected, Mr. Gordon bidding on behalf of the Dietrich Bros., topped the bid at \$20,500. I withdrew because it would have been useless to bid further since by then, I knew that he would go above \$25,000 if necessary.

My estimate of the situation was correct because all the other bidders except Gordon and myself retired at \$12,000. If he had not been there, I would have owned the Samuel Vernon tankard for the correct price of about \$12,500, and you would have had it from me at that price plus 10%.

This gives a good idea of what a good Samuel Vernon tankard should bring if the bidding is not wild; about \$13,000, or at tops, \$14,000.
