This Bonnage was originally  
in the Dawson family. It was  
owned by Albert Gallatin who  
married a Dawson. It remained  
in the hands of his family  
until Francis Gallatin who died  
in the 1930's. Francis Gallatin  
was a member of the law firm,  
Jay, Pulin, and Gallatin. One of  
the other partners, Maxwell Pulin  
purchased it. Jay Cooper inherited  
the Bonnage from her father,  
Maxwell Pulin, who died in 1946.
