The difference of 5.00 was carried over on account receivable.

I intend to have the parcels ready for express to take on Monday unless I find that on that day I can manage to drive down to deliver the silver personally to your address.

Regarding this tankard you have seen, presumably any pieces assignable individually to him are unusual. I observe there were no Joseph Rogers pieces included in the book by M. Carpenter. Does the tankard have an initials mark, or is the name struck? What kind of coin it is might also be established. Consideration of the type of tankard for Joseph Rogers' working period, and any history of local descent belonging to it, would be pertinent in conjunction with other points that examination of the piece would bring into observation.
