Portsmouth, N.H. in 1762. Their portraits
by John Brewster, Jr., of Buxton, Maine are
in the New York Institute in Saco. Thomas
Cutts 1736-1821, was one of the most prominent
merchants of early Maine.

As you are the owner of their two sauce boats
by the same maker, this information will add
more to the identification of the Colonial
ownership.
