

Tankard by John Coney, 1655 - 1722.

Plain body with straight sides tapering to the mouth, moulded base and lip, flat cover with a serrated edge, corkscrew thumbpiece, scroll handle, with a shield-shaped tip.

Engraved with arms of Monins or Monyngs, - and initials

T \* P

Height 6 1/4", D. M. 4 7/16", D. B. 3 1/4".

Mark I C above a fleur-de-lis in a heart-shaped device (Coney's earliest mark) appears.
