Jacob Hurd, Boston 1702-1758

BASTING SPOON, #189 in "Jacob Hurd & his Sons,
Silversmiths". Length 15 inches. Weight
6½ ozs. Engraved crest, a mullet, or for
MASCARENE, Boston. (latley of descendant
estate of Nathaniel Hamlen). Value upwards
from price offered. (very important piece) \$4,000.00

LARGE TANKARD engraved Arms of Winslow, #264
in Hurd book. Mark I HURD upper side left
of handle. Engraved on bottom W

I-S made
for Isaac Winslow 1671-1738 of Marshfield
Judge of Probate, Chief Justice of the court
of common pleas, and a president of the
provincial council. Warren descent, James
Warren a high sheriff in the general court,
a president of the provincial congress and
paymaster general of Washington's forces
early in Revolutionary War. Height thumb-
piece 9", cover dome 8½, rim 7" (very
important piece.) 22,000.00
