I wonder if you have approached any decision on the tankard subjects. I have submitted a folder on the John Burt (Norwood) tankard, with accompanying background history, and the photos of the Wm. Cowell tankard and can.

I would want your release before taking up either of these topics as if they were available for other responses.

I failed to mention that this Burt teapot is from the Russell through Agassiz descent. I recall that the patronage of George C. Gebelein by George Russell Agassiz who had Gebelein undertake the replica of an early English cup to be the Alexander Agassiz Cup for Inter-House Rowing at Harvard. This was in memory of George Russell's father Alexander, and presumably the middle name came from the maternal side.
