

TABLESPOONS by Paul Revere, Boston 1735-1818.

SET OF SIX, very fine in form, quality of work and preservation, ENGRAVED script "C" for Cunningham. Transaction entered in Paul Revere's Day book 1792 recording sale to William Cunningham, probably that William (1742/3-1816) merchant and two years a Selectman of Boston, son of James, Grandson of William, great grandson of Scottish immigrant Andrew Cunningham, and a first cousin of President John Adams, possibly for the son William of the 5th generation 1767-1823, a man of literary inclinations who married in 1790.
