

A s fashioned by GEBELEIN in the manner of an original Colonial example, the Gravy Bost is of heavy silver "raised" by hand—an authentic duplicate of a rare model by Stephen Emery of Boston (1725-1801).

The Beaker of solid silver--essential to the proper service of many refreshments--is a GEBELEIN adaptation of its early type. Height 41/4", top diameter 31/4".

GHE Bowl (for mayonnaise, candy, etc.) measures $4\frac{1}{2}$ " across the top and slightly over 2" high. Saucer is of heavy silver and may be used for many purposes. Diameter 6".

 \mathcal{A} HOT Muffin Dish—no other than a large Colonial design porringer with cover—is one solution for the difficult choice of a major gift that is unusual. Diameter $5\frac{1}{2}$; over all measurement including scroll-pierced handle, about 8".
