

The son of James Boyer 1700-41, a Huguenot silversmith who came with the Sigourneys and Johonnots from La Rochelle, France, and who married the daughter of Daniel Johonnot. Daniel Boyer was clerk of the market 173-458, the Sergeant of the Artillery Company in 1762, and a member of the Old South Church which he joined, 1770; he married Elizabeth, daughter of John Bulfinch, and two of his daughters married Joseph Coolidge Junior, 1747-1821, a silversmith, an ardent Son of Liberty and one of the "Boston Tea Party".
