

Antique Silver On View Today

An exhibition of Early American silver from one of the foremost collectors in America will be shown at Newton College of the Sacred Heart Sunday afternoon, March 10, from 2 to 5 o'clock. Cornelius C. Moore of Newport, R. I., is the exhibitor who will display his private collection for the first time in the Boston area. Included will be pieces never before shown in public.

The artistry and craftsmanship of such great men as Paul Revere, Peter Van Dyke, John Potwine, Jeremiah Dummer, Jonathan

Otis, John Coddington and many others, will be on view. Also, an early 16th century Bible, the first English translation of the New Testament, will be seen.

Mr. Moore, a lawyer, in Newport, has spent many years searching out his treasured collection. He will be on hand for the exhibit and will speak informally about it at 3:30.
