A2150 TABLESPOON, 9 7/8" pointed end, V backdrop, old script engraved "M D", Mark: D R in rectangle (same as A2738) \$12.00

A3833 TABLESPOON, 8 3/4", round end, back drop with worn shell. Old engraved Roman initials L*H, later old script NJO . Mark: DR (same as A2738) \$12.00

A2288 TABLE SPOON, 8 1/2" (shortened by worn end of bowl), pointed broad end, V back drop, engraved old fancy script "EH" and "RC". Mark: DR in rectangle (same as A2738) \$6.00

A4000 TEA SPOON 4 1/2" c.1770 handle back midribbed with shell drop. Engraved front T Mark: DR in indented rectangle B S \$9.00

DANIEL RUSSELL, NEWPORT c. 1721

A1418 RAT-TAIL COFFEE (small tea) SPOON, 4 1/2" engraved old initials P Mark: D R in shaped outline. I B \$48.00

NICHOLAS GEFEROY, NEWPORT 1761-1839

A4061 SET OF THREE TABLE SPOONS c.1795-1805, 9" "coffin end" bright-cut, old script initials "SLD". Condition excellent. Mark: N.GEFEROY in serrated rectangle. Set. \$42.00

SET OF SIX COFFEE (or small tea) SPOONS, length only 4 7/8" "fiddle" handles, c.1810-1820. Engraved script "ET". Mark: N.GEFEROY in serrated rectangle. Set. \$36.00
