ISAAC ANTHONY - 1690 - 1773.

Born April 10, 1690, son of Abraham and Alice Wooddell Anthony. Died in Newport 1773.

JOSEPH ANTHONY, JR. - 1762 - 1814.

Born in Newport January 15, ~~1762~~¹⁶⁹², son of Joseph and Elizabeth Sheffield Anthony.

BENJAMIN BRENTON - 1695 - 1749.

Freeman of Newport.

SAMUEL CASEY - 1723 - 1773.

JOHN CODDINGTON, - 1690 - 1743.

Son of Nathaniel and Susanna Hutchinson Coddington. Member of the House of Deputies, Sheriff 1733-1735, Colonel of Militia.

ARNOLD COLLINS, Newport - 1690.

Married Amy Ward. Received commission to make seal of Colony "Anchor and Hope" in 1702. Contributed to building of the Baptist Church. Proprietor of common council.

SAMUEL VERNON - 1683 - 1737.

Son of Daniel and Anne Vernon. In Newport, April 10, 1707, registered as a freeman in 1714. Appointed by Assembly to settle land controversy. Assisted government in investigating health conditions of the colony.

DANIEL ROGERS - 1753 - 1792.

JOSEPH ROGERS - 1760.

DANIEL RUSSELL - 1735.

JONOTHAN CLARK - 1705 - 1770.

THOMAS ARNOLD - 1739 - 1828.

Prominent citizen and continued as a goldsmith until 1796.
