



FATHER EDWARD (PAUL) DOYLE was born in Fall River, Mass., June 30, 1907. Educated in public grade and high schools, Fall River; Aquinas College, Columbus, Ohio; Providence College, Providence, R. I.; St. Rose's near Springfield, Ky.; House of Studies, River Forest, Ill.; St. Joseph's near Somerset, Ohio; House of Studies, Washington, D. C., where he also attended the Catholic University. Ordained at St. Joseph's, Columbus, Ohio, May 17, 1939, by Bishop James J. Hartley of Columbus, Ohio. Taught at Providence College, Providence, R. I., 1941-1943. Then became an army chaplain in World War II.

FATHER JOHN (THOMAS Á KEM-PIS) EULBERG was born in Portage, Wis., May 11, 1905. Educated in Immaculate Conception parochial school and a public high school, Portage; Columbia College, Dubuque, Iowa; University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wis.; St. Rose's near Springfield, Ky.; House of Studies, River Forest, Ill.; St. Joseph's near Somerset, Ohio; House of Studies, Washington, D. C. Ordained at St. Joseph's near Somerset, Ohio, May 17, 1939, by Bishop James J. Hartley of Columbus, Ohio. Parish work at Blessed Sacrament, Madison, Wis., 1940-1943. Then became a navy chaplain in World War II. Availed himself of the liberal terms of its establishment in 1939 and was affiliated to the Province of St. Albert the Great.
