Still ducking well, and
consequently feeling fine. Processing mail, arranging
for books, etc. in dobs keep me busy.

Sr Provincial, yesterday
I received your letter of Sept. 19th requesting a
uniform photo for forthcoming Dominican publication.
As you readily understand I am unable to fulfil
this request - there being no photography
shops standing where we pass through. I
trust, in your multiple tasks, you can arrange
that my obnoxious picture be taken as

a substitute. Also even if I do get a chance
in the future the time element will be against
me.

Always grateful for your letters and your
best wishes and news of the justice. Do remember
me to all the Dominicans and ever I seek their
prayers that this conflict end soon - very soon,
and my men normally resume their lives.
