Sunday - my friend with the one of the local village church. I talked at three times over - have made much progress - have been a large lot of an office, and one to him at. Have Sundays masses in church and daily in the different parishes. Had my first convert in French and baptised others in the church.

Approved of a bath at least - found a convert of Dominican sisters who run a home for the aged - they are poor & broken and have little of this world's goods - but can use the large round, unbroken tub in the old basement for an occasional bath - 'tis all the French say "c'est la question" - "this is way" - indeed.

Many Dominicans have been here before me, just unfortunately manage to miss them - correspond with Fr. Boyce Mc Carthy at Paris. This is a grand country to be a Dominican in - open welcome for Dominicans. Visited Le Havre last week. Regards to Fr. Boyce and all brethren.
