I say a Nazi church for it was built in 1935 and the civilians tell us it was all that the soldiers were allowed to attend. However there was nothing Protestant about its makeup so I hardly think I violated canon law in using it. Had a church picked out but its entire rear and altar had been blown out and the river could be seen flowing by---a bit too close to Jerry for leisure worship-

We have hopes of a real solemn Mass on Easter in the Cathedral which I have already inspected. The Archbishop isn't here so if took over would I be the second Dominican archbishop counting Albert?

Have been busy of late as you know from the newspapers, and we changed residences each night until we reached this city.
