BRONZE STAR MEDAL--CITATION

By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, and pursuant to the authority contained in paragraph 1a (1), Memorandum No. 34, Headquarters, Ninth United States Army, 8 September 1944, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to the following officer:

Captain EDWARD P. DOYLE (Army Serial Number 05321170), Corps of Chaplains, Headquarters, 413th Infantry, United States Army, for meritorious service in connection with military operations in Belgium, Holland, and Germany from 23 October 1944 to 8 May 1945. During this period of combat with the enemy, Captain Doyle performed his duties as battalion chaplain in a conspicuously meritorious manner. He constantly exposed himself to enemy fire to render assistance to his fellow soldiers. His unflinching devotion to duty and his constant ministrations to the spiritual needs of the officers and men of the battalion contributed materially to their morale and welfare. Captain Doyle's actions, above and beyond the call of duty, reflect the highest credit upon himself and the Corps of Chaplains of the United States Army. Entered military service from Fall River, Massachusetts.
