## JOINT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the President of the United States of America to proclaim October 11 of each year General Pulaski's Memorial Day for the observance and commemoration of the death of Brigadier General Casimir Pulaski.

- 1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
- 2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3       That the President of the United States is authorized and
- 4       directed to issue a proclamation calling upon officials of
- 5       the Government to display the flag of the United States
- 6       on all governmental buildings on October 11 of each year,
- 7       and inviting the people of the United States to observe the
- 8       day in schools and churches, or other suitable places, with
- 9       appropriate ceremonies in commemoration of the death of
- 10      General Casimir Pulaski.
