A BILL

To exempt from the manufacturers' excise tax typewriters intended for educational purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 3406 (a) (6) of the Internal Revenue Code
4 is hereby amended by inserting between the words "type-
5 writers" and "transcribing machines" the following:
6 "(except typewriters that are sold to educational institutions
7 and are intended for use by students in such institutions for
8 educational purposes)".
