Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend the provisions of law authorizing the granting of leave to Government employees so as to provide that such employees shall not be required to use annual leave for the purpose of preventing its accumulation.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the first section of the Act entitled "An Act to provide
- 4 for vacations to Government employees, and for other pur-
- 5 poses", approved March 14, 1936, as amended (5 U. S. C.,
- 6 sec. 30b), is amended by inserting at the end of the first
- 7 proviso therein a comma and the following: "and no em-
- 8 ployee shall be required to use such leave for the purpose
- 9 of preventing its accumulation".
