Mr. FOGARTY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the
Committee on Foreign Affairs

RESOLUTION

Whereas the House of Representatives, Sixty-fifth Congress (1919), third session, by H. J. Res. 357, duly passed a resolution declaring that the people of Ireland should have the right to determine the form of government under which they desired to live; and

Whereas, in the intervening thirty years, the people of Ireland have so determined but the effect of their determination has been thwarted, and they have in fact been deprived of the right to the form of government under which they desire to live; and

Whereas twenty-six of the thirty-two counties of Ireland have been successful in obtaining international recognition for the Republic of Ireland which has, as its basic law, a constitution modeled upon our own American Constitution: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of this House of Repre-
2 sentatives that the Republic of Ireland should embrace the
3 entire territory of Ireland unless the clear majority of all of
4 the people of Ireland, in a free plebiscite, determine and
5 declare to the contrary.
