Mr. Fogarty submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

RESOLUTION

- Whereas the House of Representatives, Sixty-fifth Congress (1919), third session, by H. J. Res. 357, duly passed a resolution declaring that the people of Ireland should have the right to determine the form of government under which they desired to live; and
- Whereas, in the intervening thirty years, the people of Ireland have so determined but the effect of their determination has been thwarted, and they have in fact been deprived of the right to the form of government under which they desire to live; and
- Whereas twenty-six of the thirty-two counties of Ireland have been successful in obtaining international recognition for the Republic of Ireland which has, as its basic law, a constitution modeled upon our own American Constitution: Now, therefore, be it
