A BILL

To protect the public health and welfare by restoring authority for factory inspections under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 704 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic
4 Act (21 U. S. C. 374) is amended by striking out the words
5 “after first making request and obtaining permission of” and
6 inserting in lieu thereof the words “after first giving written
7 notice to”.
