A BILL

To repeal section 10 of the Act entitled "An Act to provide conditions for the purchase of supplies and the making of contracts by the United States, and for other purposes", approved June 30, 1936 (the so-called Walsh-Healey Act).

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representu-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) section 10 of the Act entitled "An Act to pro-
4 vide conditions for the purchase of supplies and the making
5 of contracts by the United States, and for other purposes",
6 approved June 30, 1936, as amended (41 U. S. C. 35-45),
7 is hereby repealed.

8 (b) Sections 11 and 12 of such Act are redesignated
9 as sections 10 and 11, respectively.
