Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works

A BILL

To authorize and direct a full investigation of the problem of protecting Narragansett Bay and the southern shores of New England from hurricane tidal floods.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Army is hereby authorized and
4 directed to cause to be made, under the direction of the Chief
5 of Engineers, a complete and comprehensive examination,
6 survey, or other investigation as, in his opinion, may be re-
7 quired, of damage due to hurricane tidal floods in Narragan-
8 sett Bay and along the southern shores of New England,
9 with a view to the formulation of plans for the most effective
10 and efficient protection against such damage. The Secretary

1 of the Army is further directed to report to Congress as soon
 2 as practicable the results of such examination and survey,
 3 together with such recommendations as he may deem
 4 advisable.

5 SEC. 2. There are authorized to be appropriated such
 6 sums as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this
 7 Act.
