Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Banking and Currency

A BILL

To authorize the Public Housing Commissioner to enter into agreements with local public housing authorities for the admission of elderly persons to federally assisted low-rent housing projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 15 of the United States Housing Act of 1937
4 (42 U. S. C., sec. 1415) is amended by adding at the end
5 thereof the following new subsection:

6 “(10) The Commissioner shall include such provisions
7 in contracts made pursuant to this Act after the date of enact-
8 ment of this subsection, and he shall negotiate with the
9 public housing agencies involved such modifications of pre-

1 viously existing contracts, as may be necessary (A) to per-
2 mit persons sixty years of age or over, whose incomes do not
3 exceed applicable maximum income limits, to be admitted to
4 any low-rent housing project in any case where a duly au-
5 thorized official of the public housing agency involved deter-
6 mines that such admission will not prevent or delay the
7 admission of any eligible family to the project, and (B) to
8 provide, for persons so admitted, the same conditions for
9 continued occupancy as apply with respect to family tenants.”
