- Whereas the House of Representatives, Sixty-fifth Congress (1919), third session, by H. J. Res. 357, duly passed a resolution declaring that the people of Ireland should have the right to determine the form of government under which they desire to live; and
- Whereas the maintenance of international peace and security requires settlement of the question of the unification of Ireland; and
- Whereas twenty-six of the thirty-two counties of Ireland have been successful in obtaining international recognition for the Republic of Ireland which has, as its basic law, a constitution modeled upon our own American Constitution: Now, therefore, be it
