Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To amend section 8 of the Civil Service Retirement Act of May 29, 1930, as amended, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 8 (d) (1) of the Civil Service Retirement
4 Act of May 29, 1930, as amended by Public Law 369,
5 Eighty-fourth Congress, first session, is amended by adding
6 the following paragraph:

7 "In addition to the increase provided by paragraph (d),
8 (1) the annuity of any person, who before October 1, 1956,
9 was receiving or entitled to receive an annuity from the

1 civil service retirement and disability fund, shall be increased
 2 in accordance with the following schedule:

If annuity commenced on or after—	Annuity not in excess of \$1,500 shall be in- creased by—	Annuity in excess of \$1,500 shall be in- creased by—
October 1, 1955, and prior to October 1, 1956-----	25 per centum	10 per centum
October 1, 1954, and prior to October 1, 1955-----	26 per centum	10 per centum
October 1, 1953, and prior to October 1, 1954-----	27 per centum	10 per centum
October 1, 1952, and prior to October 1, 1953-----	28 per centum	10 per centum
October 1, 1951, and prior to October 1, 1952-----	29 per centum	10 per centum
August 20, 1920, and prior to October 1, 1951-----	30 per centum	10 per centum

3 The maximum increase provided herein for any one
 4 annuitant shall not be in excess of \$750 per annum, and
 5 shall not apply to any part of the annuity purchased by
 6 voluntary contributions.

7 SEC. 2. Section 8 (d) (1) of the Civil Service
 8 Retirement Act of May 29, 1930, as amended by Public
 9 Law 369, Eighty-fourth Congress, first session, is amended
 10 by striking out the next to the last sentence in paragraph
 11 (1) thereof.

12 SEC. 3. Section 8 (d) (2) of the Civil Service Re-
 13 tirement Act of May 29, 1930, as amended by Public Law
 14 369, is amended by striking out the word "not" and adding
 15 the following to the end of the subparagraph: "*Provided,*
 16 *however,* That the annuity of each such child shall not at any

1 time exceed \$1,200 divided by the number of children then
2 receiving annuity”.

3 SEC. 4. The widow of an employee where such em-
4 ployee had completed twenty or more years of Federal
5 service and was subject to the provisions of the Civil Serv-
6 ice Retirement Act of May 29, 1930, as amended, at the
7 time of his death, on or before April 1, 1948, while in the
8 service of the United States or retired from such service,
9 on or before such date, if such widow had been legally mar-
10 ried to such employee or retiree for a period of at least ten
11 years prior to his death and was not entitled to any an-
12 nuity based upon the service of such employee or retiree
13 under any other provisions of such Act and has not re-
14 married, shall be entitled to receive an annuity equal to
15 one-half of the annuity to which such employee or retiree
16 would have been entitled to receive or received, but not to
17 exceed \$750 per annum. Any annuity granted to a sur-
18 vivor under this section shall commence on the first day
19 and month following the month application therefor has
20 been duly filed with the Civil Service Commission, and shall
21 cease upon the death, or remarriage, of the annuitant.

22 SEC. 5. The increases in annuities, and the annuities
23 provided for in this Act, shall be paid from the civil service

1 retirement and disability fund, and such increases and such
2 annuities shall terminate on the 30th day of June after the
3 calendar year 1959, in which an appropriation shall not have
4 been made to the civil service retirement and disability fund
5 prior to July 31 of such year for the specific purpose of
6 compensating such fund for the cost as determined by the
7 Civil Service Commission of the annuities and increases pro-
8 vided by such amendments. Upon the termination of this
9 Act the provisions of law amended thereby shall be in full
10 force and effect as though this Act had not been enacted.

11 SEC. 6. The amendments made by this Act shall take
12 effect on the first day of the second month following the
13 date of its enactment.
