Mr. Fogarry introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

ABILL

- To adjust the rates of basic compensation of certain officers and employees of the Federal Government, and for other purposes.
- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That each of the existing rates of basic compensation pro-
- 4 vided in section 603 (b) of the Classification Act of 1949,
- 5 as amended (65 Stat. 612; 54 S. C. 1113 (b); and 69
- 6 Stat. 172), is hereby increased by 10 per centum of that
- 7 part which is not in excess of \$2,500 per annum, plus $24\frac{1}{2}$
- 8 per centum of that part thereof which is in excess of \$2,500
- 9 per annum, but not in excess of \$10,000 per annum, plus
- 10 27 per centum of that part which is in excess of \$10,000

- 1 per annum. Such augmented rates shall be considered to
- 2 be the regular rates of compensation provided by such
- 3 section.
- SEC. 2. Section 802 (b) of the Classification Act of
- 5 1949, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 "(b) Any officer or employee who is promoted or
- 7 transferred to a position in a higher grade shall receive
- 8 basic compensation at the lowest rate of such higher grade
- 9 which exceeds his existing rate by not less than the amount
- 10 of difference between the minimum rate of the grade from
- 11 which he is promoted or transferred and the minimum rate
- of the grade to which he is promoted or transferred. If there
- 13 is no rate in such higher grade which exceeds his existing
- 14 rate of basic compensation by the amount of such differ-
- 15 ences, such employee shall receive (A) the maximum
- 16 scheduled rate of the grade to which he is promoted or
- 17 transferred, or (B) his existing rate of basic compensation,
- 18 whichever is higher."
- 19 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect as of the first day of
- 20 the first pay period which begins after January 1, 1957.
