Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To increase the rates of basic compensation of officers and employees in the field service of the Post Office Department.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) section 301 (a) of the Postal Field Service Com-
4 pensation Act of 1955 (Public Law 68, Eighty-fourth Con-
5 gress) is amended by striking out the Postal Field Service

- 1 Schedule contained therein and inserting in lieu thereof the
 2 following new schedule:

 5 ule, as follows:

6 (1) All employees who are in step 1 immediately
 7 prior to the effective date of this Act shall be placed in
 8 step 1 of the corresponding new schedule;

9 (2) All employees who are in step 2 immediately
 10 prior to the effective date of this Act shall be placed in
 11 step 2 of the corresponding new schedule;

12 (3) All employees who are in step 3 immediately
 13 prior to the effective date of this Act shall be placed in
 14 step 3 of the corresponding new schedule; and

15 (4) All employees who are in steps 4, 5, 6, and 7
 16 immediately prior to the effective date of this Act shall
 17 be placed in step 4.

1 Nothing in this Act shall change the anniversary date of
2 employees for automatic promotion.

3 SEC. 3. This Act shall become effective as of January 1,
