Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to reduce from sixty-five to sixty the age at which old-age and other monthly insurance benefits may become payable thereunder.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 216 (a) of the Social Security Act is amended
4 by striking out "age sixty-five" and inserting in lieu thereof
5 "age sixty".

6 SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of
7 this Act shall not apply in the case of any individual who
8 died prior to the date of the enactment of this Act, and shall
9 apply only to (1) monthly benefits under section 202 of the
10 Social Security Act for months after the month in which

1 this Act is enacted, and (2) lump-sum death payments
2 under such section 202 with respect to deaths occurring on
3 or after the day on which this Act is enacted.
