A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act to reduce from sixty-five to sixty the age at which old-age and other monthly insurance benefits may become payable thereunder.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That section 216 (a) of the Social Security Act is amended
- 4 by striking out "age sixty-five" and inserting in lieu thereof
- 5 "age sixty".
- 6 SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of
- 7 this Act shall not apply in the case of any individual who
- 8 died prior to the date of the enactment of this Act, and shall
- 9 apply only to (1) monthly benefits under section 202 of the
- 10 Social Security Act for months after the month in which

- under such section 202 with respect to deaths occurring on
- or after the day on which this Act is enacted.

To amend title II of the Social Security benefits may become payable thereunder.
