Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works

## A BILL

To prohibit Government agencies to acquire or use the National Grange headquarters site without specific congressional approval.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That no portion of lot 816, square 167, in the District of  
4       Columbia (the headquarters and property of the National  
5       Grange of the Patrons of Husbandry) shall be acquired for  
6       or used by any agency of the Federal Government.

7       SEC. 2. The Administrator of the General Services Ad-  
8       ministration is directed to withdraw the declaration of taking  
9       of said lot heretofore filed by him in the United States Dis-

- 1 trict Court for the District of Columbia and to take such other
- 2 action as may be necessary to restore title to said lot to the
- 3 National Grange of the Patrons of Husbandry.
