## A BILL

- To prohibit Government agencies to acquire or use the National Grange headquarters site without specific congressional approval.
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- That no portion of lot 816, square 167, in the District of 3
- Columbia (the headquarters and property of the National
- Grange of the Patrons of Husbandry) shall be acquired for
- or used by any agency of the Federal Government.
- SEC. 2. The Administrator of the General Services Ad-
- ministration is directed to withdraw the declaration of taking
- of said lot heretofore filed by him in the United States Dis-

- trict Court for the District of Columbia and to take such other
- action as may be necessary to restore title to said lot to the
- 3 National Grange of the Patrons of Husbandry.
