Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

JOINT RESOLUTION

Requesting the President to proclaim the month of August 15, 1958, to September 15, 1958, inclusive, as National Allergy Month.

Whereas there is presently need for nationwide action for the prevention, treatment, and cure of the allergic diseases: and

Whereas the Allergy Foundation of America is working diligently in the fight against the allergic diseases; and

Whereas public understanding and support is desperately needed in order to provide adequate treatment for allergy sufferers, adequate research in the field of prevention, treatment, and cure of the allergic diseases, and to promote adequate public and professional allergy education: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the President of the United States is authorized and
4 requested to issue a proclamation designating the month
5 beginning August 15, 1958, and ending September 15,
6 1958, as National Allergy Month, and urging the people
7 throughout the Nation to cooperate in the fight for the pre-
8 vention, treatment, and cure of allergic illness, and inviting
9 the communities of the United States to observe such month
10 with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
