AN ACT

To encourage expansion of teaching in the education of mentally retarded children through grants to institutions of higher learning and to State educational agencies.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the Commissioner of Education is authorized to make
- 4 grants to public or other nonprofit institutions of higher
- 5 learning to assist them in providing training of professional
- 6 personnel to conduct training of teachers in fields related
- 7 to education of mentally retarded children. Such grants may
- 8 be used by such institutions to assist in covering the cost of
- 9 courses of training or study for such personnel and for

- 1 establishing and maintaining fellowships, with such stipends
- 2 as may be determined by the Commissioner of Education.
- 3 Sec. 2. The Commissioner of Education is also author-
- 4 ized to make grants to State educational agencies to assist
- 5 them in establishing and maintaining, directly or through
- 6 grants to public or other nonprofit institutions of higher
- 7 learning, fellowships or traineeships for training personnel
- 8 engaged or preparing to engage in employment as teachers of
- 9 mentally retarded children or as supervisors of such teachers.
- 10 Sec. 3. Payments of grants pursuant to this Act may be
- 11 made by the Commissioner of Education from time to time,
- 12 in advance or by way of reimbursement, on such conditions
- 13 as the Commissioner may determine. Such payments shall
- 14 not exceed \$1,000,000 for any one fiscal year.
- SEC. 4. Each State educational agency and each public
- 16 or other nonprofit institution of higher education which
- 17 receives a grant under this Act during a fiscal year shall
- 18 after the end of such fiscal year submit a report to the Com-
- 19 missioner of Education. Such report shall contain a detailed
- 20 financial statement showing the purposes for which the funds
- 21 granted under this Act were expended.
- SEC. 5. For purposes of this Act—
- (a) The term "nonprofit institution" means an insti-
- 24 tution owned and operated by one or more corporations or
- 25 associations no part of the net earnings of which inures, or

- 1 may lawfully inure, to the benefit of any private shareholder
- 2 or individual.
- 3 (b) The term "State educational agency" means the
- 4 State board of education or other agency or officer primarily
- 5 responsible for State supervision of public elementary and
- 6 secondary schools in the State.
- 7 Sec. 6. The Commissioner of Education is authorized
- 8 to delegate any of his functions under this Act, except the
- 9 making of regulations, to any officer or employee of the
- 10 Office of Education.
- 11 SEC. 7. This Act shall continue in effect until a date
- 12 ten years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
