## ABILL

To amend the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 to permit donations of surplus property to volunteer fire-fighting organizations, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That (a) the first sentence of section 203 (j) (1) of the
- 4 Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949
- 5 (40 U.S.C., sec. 484 (j) (1)) is amended to read as
- 6 follows: "Under such regulations as he may prescribe, the
- 7 Administrator is authorized in his discretion to donate
- 8 without cost (except for direct costs of care and handling)
- 9 for use in any State for purposes of education, public health,
- 10 or civil defense, or for research for any such purpose, or for

- 1 the purpose of aiding in the protection of life and property
- 2 by volunteer fire-fighting organizations, any equipment, ma-
- 3 terials, books, or other supplies (including those capitalized
- 4 in a working capital or similar fund) under the control of
- 5 any executive agency which shall have been determined to
- 6 be surplus property and which shall have been determined
- 7 under paragraph (2), (3), or (4) of this subsection to be
- 8 usable and necessary for any such purpose."
- 9 (b) The last sentence of section 203 (j) (1) of such
- 10 Act is amended by inserting before the period at the end
- 11 thereof the following: ", except that notwithstanding a
- 12 State agency is not designated under State law for the
- 13 purpose of distributing property for use by volunteer fire-
- 14 fighting organizations, such property may be transferred to
- 15 such State agency for use for purposes of education, public
- 16 health, or civil defense, or for research for any such purpose".
- SEC. 2. (a) The first sentence of section 203 (j) (3)
- 18 of such Act (40 U.S.C., sec. 484 (j) (3)) is amended
- 19 to read as follows: "Determination whether such surplus
- 20 property (except surplus property allocated in conformity
- 21 with paragraph (2) of this subsection) is usable and neces-
- 22 sary for purposes of education or public health, or for research
- 23 for any such purpose, or for the purpose of aiding in the
- 24 protection of life and property by volunteer fire-fighting
- 25 organizations, in any State shall be made by the Secretary

- 1 of Health, Education, and Welfare, who shall allocate such
- 2 property on the basis of needs and utilization for transfer
- 3 by the Administrator to such State agency for distribution
- 4 to (A) tax-supported medical institutions, hospitals, clinics,
- 5 health centers, school systems, schools, colleges, and uni-
- 6 versities, (B) other nonprofit medical institutions, hospitals,
- 7 clinics, health centers, schools, colleges, and universities
- 8 which are exempt from taxation under section 501 (c) (3)
- 9 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or (C) to any in-
- 10 corporated or unincorporated volunteer fire department, fire
- 11 company, or other similar fire-fighting organization which
- 12 is tax-supported or has been held exempt from taxation
- 13 under section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954."
