Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 so as to increase the minimum hourly wage from \$1.00 to \$1.25.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of section 6 of the
4 Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended (29 U.S.C.,
5 sec. 206 (a) (1)), is hereby amended by striking out "not
6 less than \$1.00 an hour" and inserting in lieu thereof "not
7 less than \$1.25 an hour".

8 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on the first day of
9 the first month which begins more than thirty days after the
10 date of its enactment.
