Relating to the classification of certain articles as braids under paragraph 1529 (a) of the Tariff Act of 1930.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That paragraph 1529 (a) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19

4 U.S.C., sec. 1001, par. 1529 (a)) is amended by adding at

5 the end thereof the following: "No article consisting of a

6 braided tube or sheath with a core or filler shall be excluded

7 from classification under this subparagraph as a braid."

8 SEC. 2. The foregoing amendment to the Tariff Act of

9 1930 shall enter into force on a date to be specified by the

10 President in a notice to the Secretary of the Treasury fol-

11 lowing such negotiations as may be necessary to effect a

1 modification or a termination of any international obligations
2 of the United States with which the amendment might con-
3 flict, but in any event not later than one hundred and eighty
4 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
