Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend title II of the Social Security Act so as to remove the limitation upon the amount of outside income which may be received by an individual while receiving benefits thereunder.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) subsections (c), (d), (e), (g), (h), (j), and
4 (k) of section 203 of the Social Security Act are repealed.

5 (b) Subsection (b) of such section 203 is amended—

6 (1) by striking out "Work or" in the heading,

7 (2) by striking out paragraphs (1) and (2)

8 thereof, and

9 (3) by redesignating paragraphs (3), (4), and

1 (5) thereof as paragraphs (1), (2), and (3),
2 respectively.

3 (c) Subsection (f) of such section 203 is redesignated
4 as subsection (g) ; ~~and such subsection as so redesignated is~~
5 amended by striking out "or (c)" each time it appears
6 therein, and by striking out "(other than an event described
7 in subsection (b) (1) or (c) (1))".

8 (d) Subsection (l) of such section 203 is redesignated
9 as subsection (d) ; and such subsection as so redesignated is
10 amended by striking out "subsection (f) or (g)" and insert-
11 ing in lieu thereof "subsection (c)".

12 (e) Section 202 (n) (1) of the Social Security Act is
13 amended by striking out "Section 203 (b) and (c)" and
14 inserting in lieu thereof "Section 203 (b)".

15 SEC. 2. The amendments made by the first section of
16 this Act shall apply only with respect to monthly benefits
17 under section 202 of the Social Security Act for months be-
18 ginning after the date on which this Act is enacted.
