Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Post Office and Civil Service

A BILL

To provide that employees whose basic compensation is fixed and adjusted from time to time in accordance with prevailing rates by wage boards or similar administrative authority serving the same purpose, shall be paid on a weekly basis.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That title VI, section 604 (b), of the Federal Employees
4 Pay Act of 1945, as amended, be further amended as fol-
5 lows:

6 "SEC. 604. (b) Beginning not later than October 1,
7 1961, each pay period for all officers and employees of the
8 organizations referred to in subsection (a), except those

1 employees whose basic compensation is fixed and adjusted
2 from time to time in accordance with prevailing rates by
3 wage boards or similar administrative authority serving the
4 same purpose, and officers and employees on the Isthmus of
5 Panama in the service of the Canal Zone Government or the
6 Panama Canal Company, shall cover two administrative
7 workweeks.”
