## A BILL

To amend the Act of September 6, 1958, relating to expansion of teaching in the education of mentally retarded children so as to make it applicable to the other areas of exceptionality, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the first and second sections of the Act of September 6,  
4       1958 (72 Stat. 1777) are each amended by inserting “, hard  
5       of hearing, speech impaired, visually handicapped, deaf,  
6       emotionally disturbed, or socially maladjusted, crippled, and  
7       other health impaired” after the phrase “mentally retarded.”

8       SEC. 2. Section 3 of such Act is amended by striking out  
9       the last sentence thereof.
