Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To provide for the production and distribution of educational and training films for use by deaf persons, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) the first section of the Act entitled "An Act
4 to provide in the Department of Health, Education, and
5 Welfare for a loan service of captioned films for the deaf",
6 approved September 2, 1958 (72 Stat. 1742), is amended
7 to read as follows:

8 "That the objectives of this Act are—

9 " (a) to promote the general welfare of deaf per-
10 sons by: (1) bringing to such persons understanding
11 and appreciation of those films which play such an

1 important part in the general and cultural advancement
2 of hearing persons, (2) providing through these films
3 enriched educational and cultural experiences through
4 which deaf persons can be brought into better touch
5 with the realities of their environment, and (3) provid-
6 ing a wholesome and rewarding experience which deaf
7 persons may share together; and

8 “(b) to promote the educational advancement of
9 deaf persons by: (1) carrying on research in the use
10 of educational and training films for the deaf, (2) pro-
11 ducing and distributing educational and training films
12 for the deaf, and (3) training persons in the use of films
13 for the deaf.”

14 (b) Section 4 of such Act is amended to read as follows:

15 “SEC. 4. There are hereby authorized to be appropriated
16 for each fiscal year such funds as may be necessary to carry
17 out the objectives set forth in this Act.”
