### A BILL

To prohibit the sending as franked mail of solicitations for the transfer from one State to another State of business enterprises and operations, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 That section 4161 of title 39, United States Code (relating 3 to the sending in the mail as franked mail of official cor-4 respondence of Members of Congress and other officials), is 5 amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence: 6 "The authority contained in this section shall not be held or 7 considered to authorize the sending in the mail as franked 8 mail of any matter which directly or indirectly advocates, 9 requests, or otherwise solicits in any manner the transfer 10
