A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, so as to restore competitive equality to retailers and other distributors with respect to certain sales to business and other organizations.

- 3 That it is the purpose of this Act to correct a situation
- 4 whereby an important segment of the small business com-
- 5 munity has been deprived of the ability to compete for a

- 8 businesses in question at a disadvantage, competitively, with
