## IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

### A BILL

To provide for the production and distribution of educational and training films for use by deaf persons, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That (a) the first section of the Act entitled "An Act to  
4 provide in the Department of Health, Education, and Wel-  
5 fare for a loan service of captioned films for the deaf", ap-  
6 proved September 2, 1958 (72 Stat. 1742), is amended to  
7 read as follows:

8 "That the objectives of this Act are—

9 " (a) to promote the general welfare of deaf per-  
10 sons by (1) bringing to such persons understanding and

1 appreciation of those films which play such an important  
2 part in the general and cultural advancement of hear-  
3 ing persons, (2) providing, through these films, en-  
4 riched educational and cultural experiences through  
5 which deaf persons can be brought into better touch  
6 with the realities of their environment, and (3) provid-  
7 ing a wholesome and rewarding experience which deaf  
8 persons may share together; and

9 “(b) to promote the educational advancement of  
10 deaf persons by (1) carrying on research in the use of  
11 educational and training films for the deaf, (2) pro-  
12 ducing and distributing educational and training films  
13 for the deaf, and (3) training persons in the use of films  
14 for the deaf.”

15 (b) Paragraphs (4), (5), and (6) of section 3 (b) of  
16 such Act are redesignated as paragraphs (5), (6), and (7),  
17 respectively, and there is inserted after paragraph (3) the  
18 following:

19 “(4) provide for the conduct of research in the use  
20 of educational and training films for the deaf, for the  
21 production and distribution of training films for the deaf,  
22 and for the training of persons in the use of films for the  
23 deaf.”

- 1 (c) Section 4 of such Act is amended to read as follows:
- 2 "SEC. 4. There are hereby authorized to be appropriated
- 3 for each fiscal year such funds as may be necessary to carry
- 4 out the objectives of this Act."
