Any vacancy occur-4 ring in the membership of the committee shall be filled in 5 the manner in which the original appointment was made. 6 The said committee is directed to make a complete, 7 full, and thorough investigation of the numerous research 8

9 programs being conducted by sundry departments and
10 agencies of the Federal Government and, without limiting
11 the generality of the foregoing, the committee shall give
12 special attention to the following: (1) the overall total

amount of annual expenditures on research programs; (2) 1 2 what departments and agencies of the Government are con-3 ducting research, at what costs and with what results; (3) the amounts being expended by the various agencies and 4 departments in grants for research to colleges, private in-5 6 dustry, and every form of student scholarships; (4) what 7 facilities, if any, exist for coordinating the various and sundry research programs, including grants to colleges and univer-8 9 sities as well as scholarship grants.

10 The committee shall report its findings to the House with 11 such recommended legislation as the committee may deem 12 appropriate to correct any deficiencies. The committee shall 13 make such reports to the House prior to September 1, 1964, and may submit such interim reports as it deems advisable. 14 Any reports submitted when the House is not in session may 15 be filed with the Clerk of the House. 16 For the purposes of this resolution the committee, or 17 any subcommittee thereof, is authorized to sit and act during 18 the present Congress at such times and places within the 19 United States, whether or not the House has recessed or 20adjourned, to hold such hearings, to require the attendance 21 of such witnesses and the production of such books, papers, 22

23 and documents, and to take such testimony as the commit-

24 tee deems necessary. Subpenas may be issued under the

25 signature of the chairman of the committee or any properly
