IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

MR. FOGARTY submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

- 1 *Resolved*, That there is hereby created a select com-
2 mittee to be composed of five Members of the House of
3 Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker, one of
4 whom he shall designate as chairman. Any vacancy occur-
5 ring in the membership of the committee shall be filled in
6 the manner in which the original appointment was made.
- 7 The said committee is directed to make a complete,
8 full, and thorough investigation of the numerous research
9 programs being conducted by sundry departments and
10 agencies of the Federal Government and, without limiting
11 the generality of the foregoing, the committee shall give
12 special attention to the following: (1) the overall total

1 amount of annual expenditures on research programs; (2)
2 what departments and agencies of the Government are con-
3 ducting research, at what costs and with what results; (3)
4 the amounts being expended by the various agencies and
5 departments in grants for research to colleges, private in-
6 dustry, and every form of student scholarships; (4) what
7 facilities, if any, exist for coordinating the various and sundry
8 research programs, including grants to colleges and univer-
9 sities as well as scholarship grants.

10 The committee shall report its findings to the House with
11 such recommended legislation as the committee may deem
12 appropriate to correct any deficiencies. The committee shall
13 make such reports to the House prior to September 1, 1964,
14 and may submit such interim reports as it deems advisable.
15 Any reports submitted when the House is not in session may
16 be filed with the Clerk of the House.

17 For the purposes of this resolution the committee, or
18 any subcommittee thereof, is authorized to sit and act during
19 the present Congress at such times and places within the
20 United States, whether or not the House has recessed or
21 adjourned, to hold such hearings, to require the attendance
22 of such witnesses and the production of such books, papers,
23 and documents, and to take such testimony as the commit-
24 tee deems necessary. Subpenas may be issued under the
25 signature of the chairman of the committee or any properly

1 designated chairman of a subcommittee, or any member
2 designated by him and may be served by any person desig-
3 nated by such chairman or member. The chairman of the
4 committee or any member thereof may administer oaths
5 to witnesses.

6 The majority of the members of the committee shall
7 constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, except
8 two or more shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of
9 taking of evidence, including sworn testimony.
